



**Day One** (Typically Friday, 6:30—8:00 p.m.)

- Open with Worship, Praise
- Biblical teaching: “Crisis of Conviction” – personal testimony of Manny Mill or “Believe!” – teaching on character of God/Questions of Origin, Purpose, Morality, Justice, Destiny
- Questions and Answers
- Video: Lake County Jail visit with Bishop Eugene Tanniehill
- Corporate Prayer Time – focused on repentance and Psalm 51

**Day Two – First Session** (Typically Saturday, 8:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m./inmate lunch time)

- Open with Worship, Praise
- Biblical teaching: Structure of the Lord’s Prayer, Luke 11:1-4
- Questions and Answers
- Testimony of Praying “Hallowed be Thy Name” – video of Radical Time Out™
- Corporate Prayer Time – Hallowed Be Your Name – Change Me

**Day Two – Second Session** (Typically Saturday, 12 noon/after inmate lunch – 2:30 p.m.)

- Open with Worship, Praise
- Biblical teaching: The Odd Parable, Luke 11:5-8
- Questions and Answers
- Testimony: Diego’s Story, a Story of Persistence
- Individual Prayer Time – repent of wrong perceptions of God
- Small Group Prayer – hallowing God’s name through various church ministries
- Communion Service

**Day Three – Two Sessions** (Typically same schedule as Saturday)

- Open with Worship, Praise
- Video Testimony: Radical Reconciliation – a story 10 years in the making
- Biblical teaching: Going for the How Much More, Luke 11:9-13
- Prayer Time – focusing on forgiveness and reconciliation
- Praying the Scriptures – a practical exercise
- Presentation of Conference Certificates
- Commissioning Time – George Whitfield’s prayer
